Children with disability are more vulnerable in our communities and will benefit from your programs and events where reasonable adjustments are anticipated. This workshop will identify the effects of disability and the possible impacts on access for children living with:

- Autism spectrum disorders
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Learning difficulties
- Physical disabilities
- Blind and low vision
- Deaf and hard of hearing
- Chronic and ongoing medical conditions e.g. chemical sensitivity, epilepsy
- Mental health conditions e.g. anxiety
- Acquired brain injuries
- Genetic disorders

The workshop will provide a brief overview and guidance of the law in this area as well as provide opportunities to reflect on changes to your service, program or events delivery to make it more inclusive of children with disability.
