



The gift that art classes give a child is more than acquiring technical skills to enhance their innate creativity.

Such skills enable children to translate their world visually and communicate what they see to others.

However, a good art teacher will always focus on individual expression, with creative thinking and problem-solving skills as intangible learning outcomes.

Children experience different types of art materials and processes over time (eg, drawing, painting, printing, ceramics, sculpture), learning technical skills through project-based classes, whilst receiving personal guidance and encouragement.

Yrs 1-3 'Introduction to Colour'

Beginners' class in painting - guided exploration of colour mixing. Children create their first masterpieces on canvas.

Yrs 4-6 'Introduction to Drawing'

Students learn the secrets of *how to see* and make their mark, exploring line and tone. Get the edge on drawing techniques.

TERM 3:

Yrs 1-3 'Soft Sculpture: Textiles'

We take a good look at faces and features, stitching together a unique, felt face soft sculpture. "*Who nose what eye might make...?*"

Yrs 4-6 'Switched-On Sculpture'

Shining a light on sculpture techniques, we work together to create fantastic wire and *papier-mâché* lanterns, celebrating the night!

TERM 4:

Children look at the work of some of the French modern masters and create their own 2D artworks using mixed media.

Yrs 4-6 'Ceramics – Gingerbread Houses'

Art meets architecture - Students sculpt a functional clay work of their own design using slab technique.
